Pastel helps keep your finger on the pulse of your business



Pastel Control Centre is included in Pastel Partner 2004 and 2005, and gives you the functionality needed to continuously monitor key activities in your company - easily.

Many smaller business environments need information at their fingertips that will allow them to monitor operational activities and act on them instantly. Having better insight into your business simply means having more control over it. If stock reaches a critical level, for instance, or a customer's account balance exceeds a certain amount, Pastel Control Centre can ensure that an alert is generated and routed directly to the person meant to receive it. Control Centre is a useful feature in Pastel Partner that could make your job much easier.

What can be monitored?

To Do List: Monitor items that are due or overdue, such as quotations; invoices; and notes.

Financial Category Balance: Monitor the total of a financial category, such as Bank, Accounts Receivables and so on.

Financial Category Movement: Monitor daily movement of a financial category, such as Bank.

General Ledger Account Balance: Monitor a general ledger account's balance.

General Ledger Account Movement: Monitor a general ledger account's daily movement.

Customer Balance: Monitor customer balances.

Inventory Quantity Balance: Monitor the current quantity on hand for the selected inventory item.

Inventory Quantity Movement: Monitor the daily quantity movement for a selected inventory item.

How to get started

Once you start the Control Centre, open the company you wish to monitor and set the period and date for the activity you wish to monitor. Partner 2004 and 2005 defaults to the last period and today's date.

Up to ten separate items can be monitored at the same time. Simply decide what information you would like to monitor and how frequently to refresh the values. By setting a critical value for each monitor, the system displays an onscreen message and/or sends an e-mail when the value is reached.

Each individual monitor as well as the Control Centre screen can be positioned and resized. You can also specify separate refresh intervals in minutes per monitor to, for example, monitor sales every 60 minutes.

All settings are saved in a configuration file, so at the next Control Centre start-up, when the configuration file is opened, the same monitors are displayed in the same positions. The Control Centre icon can also be configured to automatically open a specific company and specific configuration file as it starts.
